An Update from Rodney

A missionary's work cannot and should not be done without the help of national partners. A national partner is a person from the local culture who serves with us in ministry. These national partners know the culture and the language better than we ever will be able to. As you might recall, Rodney Chirinos and his wife, Sara, have been serving alongside us full-time since the launch of Seminario Biblico Reformado two years ago.

As we are in the USA on Home Ministry Assignment, Rodney is already hard at work in Medellin, Colombia. I asked him to write a brief update, which I've translated below. He writes,

Hi, I'm Rodney Chirinos, and I'm currently with my wife, Sara, in Medellin, Colombia. I am working as an Academic Assistant at the Nueva Providencia Bible School. A new group of students will enter in January 2020, and my work will consist of mentoring this new group, as well as the teaching and application of the Third Millennium Ministry curriculum. This is possible thanks to the experience I acquired in Arequipa, Peru, with Seminario Biblico Reformado.

Currently, while the students are not yet on campus, I am working in various areas that have to do with the development and formation of the virtual classroom of the school, the preparation of classes, presentations and exams, and collaborating in graphic design areas.

I am very grateful to the Lord for being able to serve in this area that has to do with the preparation of men and women for ministry. And later, with the arrival of MTW missionaries to Medellin, we strive to extend the kingdom of God through the planting of biblical churches in eastern Antioquia (the cities of Medellin & Rio Negro).

We are deeply grateful to all who are praying for us and our ministry, and contributing so that our work continues to grow. Know that the Lord has blessed our efforts and that the work for the advancement of the kingdom is not in vain.
